This approach encourages the children to consider how their behaviour impacts on those around them and to take more responsibility for their own actions.

As a school the staff have worked hard to create a set of overarching rights and responsibilities. These are displayed in each classroom and explored with the children during the year through PSHE lessons. The children's contributions are added to the classroom displays to reflect their ideas and to ensure that they have ownership over what happens within their own class.
